From the Pastor's Pen....

Hebrews 4:12 says, "For the word of God is <u>living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword</u>, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and <u>able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart."</u> The Bible, God's word is characterized in a number of ways in this verse. First...



It is **living** – That means it has a vital power in itself and it can exert this power in our lives. The Bible is not just words on paper, it is inspired by God and is alive. It can live in our hearts and be lived out in our lives.

It is **active** – That means it is operative and it functions in order to have effect upon our lives. The Bible is supposed to convict us and speak directly to us today.

It is **sharp** and **piercing** - That means it is very sharp as if it can cut something with one blow instead of with repeated blows. And it can penetrate, cut right down to our soul and spirit. The Bible can and will pierce our hearts to the very core of our being. The Bible can cut deep—to the heart-level. It can cut through everything in our lives, even through our soul and our spirit, as with a knife that cuts through joints and even into the marrow of bone - spiritually speaking.

It is a **judge** – That means the word of God is able to discern, perceive or recognize and make right judgments about our thoughts and intentions. When the Bible cuts deep it has the capacity to judge not just our thoughts but also our very motives, attitudes, and intentions.

The Word of God can do a lot of things in our lives. Yet I have noticed that when I have become spiritually complacent and find myself drifting then **the Word of God has fallen flat in my life.** When God's Word no longer feeds us it is because we've moved. God's Word is living and active. The Spirit of God speaks through it to move us and transform us into the image of Jesus. When it no longer has that affect, we have drifted from God's instruction. We no longer hunger and thirst for God and His righteousness **(Matthew 5:6)**

I realize some people don't want any authority speaking to them, even if it's God and His word. They just want to be their own authority. I realize some people don't want an eternal word; they want a "god" of their own making. I realize some people don't want something gospel-focused because then they'd have to admit they need salvation.

On the other hand some people like those things about God's Word, even if it pierces a little. That means God helps them, encourages them, gives grace to them, and invites them to live under the Kingdom reign of Jesus. They know the word of God builds them up and sends them out.

Please don't allow God's word to fall flat in your life. God's Word is not just about behavior modification, it is about conviction, embracing sacrifice, and being willing to submit. It is about allowing God's Word to break us down in order to build us up again more and more in Jesus' image. It is about forgiveness and life change.

In September small groups and Sunday School and Bible studies begin again. These are places where God's word can do its needed work in our lives. I pray that if you are not a part of any of these groups you would consider joining. I pray our lives are all submitting regularly and even daily to the Word of God that is, "...living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword... able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart." May our lives ever more be conformed to Christ's image through the Word of God.

Please know that I love you and desire that we all become more like Jesus.


Scrap & Craft
